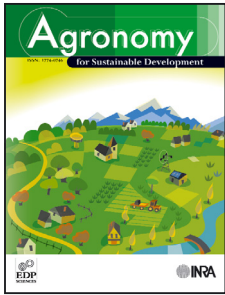

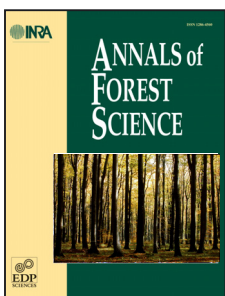
AIMS AND SCOPE

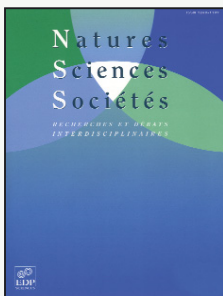

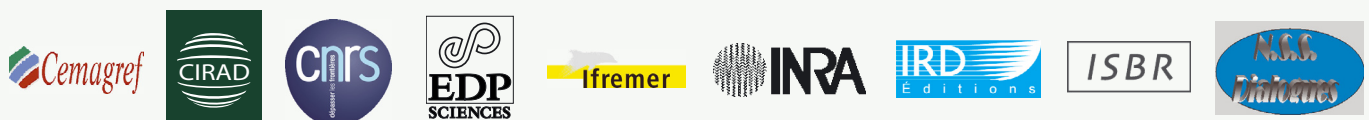
